1 - The setting: When Paul first comes to Corinth (Acts 17)

a.) He proclaimed the testimony of God

i.) Not with lofty speech or wisdom (Greek rhetoric)

2 - Jesus Christ and Him crucified

3 - It is scary!

4 - But it is not your message and doesn't depend on your delivery

5 - The Why? "So that....."
